What Is The Cheapest Way to Cook A Chicken?

The lowest Cost to Cook is __Slow Cooker_____

Below is a pricing grid to help everyone understand the cost of cooking. These figures are based on an average appliance found within UK households and the costs are accurate as of January 2023.

Appliance	10 Minutes	30 Minutes	60 Minutes	90 Minutes
Air Fryer Electric	11	33	66	99
Electric Hob	9	27	54	81
Microwave	5	15	30	45
Electric Oven	12	36	72	108
Slow Cooker	1	3	6	9
Electric Toaster	7	21	42	63
Gas Hob	1.5	4.5	9	13.5
Gas Oven	2.5	7.5	15	22.5

To work out how much it costs for other times the sum below will help

(10 minute cost / 10) x Number of minutes cooking time

You have decided to cook a whole chicken for your household to enjoy. The chicken is of average size weighing about 1.2Kg. You have recently seen a video online showing a chicken being cooked in a Slow Cooker and thought you would try this method of cooking, but what appliance would be the cheapest to use?

and thought you would try this method of cooking, but what appliance would be the cheapest to use:
In the Slow Cooker the medium chicken will take 4 hours to cook.
Cost to Cook in a Slow Cooker is 24 Pence
In an Electric Oven you would need to pre-heat the oven for 10 minutes and the chicken would take 1.5 hours to cook.
Cost to Cook in an Electric Oven is120 Pence
In a Gas Oven you would need to pre-heat the oven for 10 minutes and the chicken would take 1.5 hours to cook.
Cost to Cook in a Gas Oven is <u>25 Pence</u>
If using an Air Fryer, you would need to pre-heat the Air Fryer for 3 minutes and then cook the chicken for a further 55 minutes.
Cost to Cook in an Air Fryer is <u>63.8 Pence</u>

The highest Cost to Cook is __Electric Oven_
